

OFFICIAL CALL
Republican Party Canvass
of the Cave Spring Magisterial District

As Chairman of the Roanoke County Republican Committee and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, David R. Suetterlein, do hereby issue this call for a Magisterial District Party Canvass to be held at South County Library, located at 6303 Merriman Road, Roanoke or its alternate site, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. local time on Saturday, May 2, 2015 for the purpose of nominating a Republican candidate for the office of Cave Spring District Supervisor to be voted for in the general election on November 3, 2015.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Roanoke County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

A voter who, subsequent to making a statement of intent, publicly supports a candidate in opposition to a Republican nominee shall not be qualified for participation in party actions for a period of four years.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party with in the last five years. A single exception to this shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception identified in this paragraph thereafter. Within 30 days of receipt, the Official Committee shall provide a copy of this signed renunciation statement to the Republican Party of Virginia, to be maintained for a period of five years.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for the Republican nomination at said canvass must prefile a written statement on a completed official filing form provided by the Roanoke County Republican Committee to the Roanoke County Republican Committee, PO Box 20923 - Roanoke, Virginia 24018 or by physical delivery to 4121 Given Road, Salem, Virginia which must be received not later than 5 p.m. on Tuesday, March 31, 2015. Postmarks do not govern. Candidates for nomination shall include a \$400.00 check to the Roanoke County Republican Committee when they submit their written statement. The official filing form is available at www.RoanokeRepublicans.com and at 4121 Given Road, Salem, Virginia. If only one candidate properly files, then said candidate shall be declared the Republican nominee and no canvass will be held.
