OFFICIAL CALL Mass Meeting of Craig County of the Republican Party of Virginia

- d) Electing up to 55 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 9th District Convention, to be held on Saturday, April 12, 2014 at George Wythe High School, #1 Maroon Way, Wytheville, VA or its alternate site, beginning at 10:00 a.m. local time for the purposes of electing a 9th District Chairman of the Republican Party;
- e) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Craig County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party within the last five years.

A single exception to this shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of this writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the forgoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception thereafter.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for election as Unit Chairman must prefile a written statement of their intent on a form provided by the Committee to the Craig County Republican Committee, PO Box 681, New Castle, VA 24127 or by physical delivery to Chairman Jesse Spence which must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 3, 2014. Craig County Committee member, Delegates or Alternate to the April 12th District Convention and/or as Delegate or Alternate to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention may prefile a written statement of their intent on a form provided by the Committee to the Craig County Republican Committee, PO Box 681, New Castle, VA 24127 or by physical delivery to Chairman Jesse Spence which must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 3, 2014 or attend the mass meeting. Registration Fees and Additional Information

There will be no registration fee to participate in this mass meeting. Craig County Committee membership dues are \$10. There is a voluntary registration fee of \$35 to participate in the Republican State Convention and a \$5 voluntary registration fee to participate in the 9th District Convention.
