

**OFFICIAL CALL**  
Mass Meeting of the Grayson County Unit  
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Grayson County Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by Committee, I, James D. Wagoner, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Courtroom of the Grayson County Courthouse, 129 Davis Street, Independence, Virginia, starting at 7:00 p.m. local time on Tuesday, April 3, 2012, for the following purposes:

1. To elect a unit chairman, vice-chairman, treasurer, secretary, and members to the unit committee.
2. Electing up to 150 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to The Republican Party of Virginia State Convention, to be held on June 16, 2012, at the Greater Richmond Convention Center, beginning at 10:00 a.m. for the purposes of electing a State Party Chairman, RNC National Committeeman, RNC National Committeewoman, 13 At-Large Delegates and 13 At-Large Alternate Delegates to the RNC Convention, and two At-Large Presidential Electors. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Grayson County is entitled to 30 Delegate Votes;
3. Electing up to 150 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 9<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Convention to be held on Saturday, April 28, 2012, at the George Wythe High School, #1 Maroon Way, Wytheville, VA beginning at 10:00 a.m. for the purposes of electing a District Chairman, three Delegates and three Alternate Delegates to the RNC Convention, and nominating one Presidential Elector from the Ninth Congressional District. Each unit is entitled to one Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Grayson County is entitled to 30 Delegate Votes;
4. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

**Qualifications for Participation:**

All legal and qualified voters of Grayson County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions, or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

**Registration Fees:**

There will be no registration fee to participate in this Mass Meeting.
