Mass Meeting of the Lee County Committee
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Lee County Republican Committee, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Roger Elkins, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Lee County Courthouse, Circuit Court Courtroom, 33640 Main Street, Jonesville, Virginia 24263 or its alternative site, starting at 7:00 p.m. local time on March 27, 2014 for the following purpose:

- a) Electing a Lee County Republican Committee Chairperson;
- b) Electing Officers of the Lee County Republican Committee as follows: Vice-Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer;
- c) Electing members of the Lee County Republican Committee;
- d) Electing up to 185 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Ninth Congressional District Republican Committee Convention, to be held on Saturday, April 12, 2014 at the George Wythe High School, #1 Maroon Way, Wytheville, Virginia 24382, or its alternate site, beginning at 10:00 a.m. local time for the purpose of electing a District Chairperson of the Ninth Congressional District Republican Committee. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Lee County is entitled to 37 Delegate Votes;
- e) Electing up to 205 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia's State Convention, to be held on Saturday, June 7, 2014 at the Roanoke Civic Center, 710 Williamson Road, Roanoke, Virginia 24016, or its alternate site, beginning at 10:00 a.m. local time for the purpose of nominating a Republican candidate for United States Senate. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Lee County is entitled to 41 Delegate Votes;
- f) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Lee County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements

There will be NO pre-filing requirements for this mass meeting.

Registration Fee

There will be NO registration fee to participate in this Mass Meeting.

However, The Republican Party of Virginia is requesting a voluntary \$35 filing fee from all individuals seeking election as a Delegate to the State Convention and the Ninth Congressional District Republican Committee is requesting a voluntary \$5 filing fee from all individuals seeking election as a Delegate to the Ninth Congressional District Convention . Checks need to be made out to the “Lee County Republican Committee”.
