

OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of Norton City Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia

The Norton City Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, does hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held on Sunday, March 30, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at the SLEMP LAW OFFICE, PLLC, 413 East Main Street, Wise, Virginia 24293 for the following purposes:

- A) Electing a Unit Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer
- B) Electing members of the Unit Committee
- C) Electing up to 30 delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the 9th Congressional District Republican Convention, to be held on Saturday, April 12, 2014 at George Wythe High School, #1 Maroon Way, Wytheville, Virginia 24382, or its alternative site, beginning at 10:00 a.m. local time for the purpose of electing a 9th District Chairman of the Republican Party. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes cast for Governor and President at their last election, so that Norton is entitled to 6 Delegate Votes.
- D) Electing up to 30 delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia Convention, to be held Saturday, June 7, 2014 at the Roanoke Civic Center, 710 Williamson Road, Roanoke, Virginia or its alternate site beginning at 10:00 a.m. local time for the purpose of nominating a Republican candidate for the U.S. Senate. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes cast for Governor and President at their last election, so that Norton is entitled to 6 Delegate Votes.
- E) And for the transaction of such business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of the City of Norton under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts. Voters may be required to produce personal identification such as a valid driver's license or voter registration card in order to participate in the mass meeting or convention.

Registration Fees and Additional Information

There will be no registration fee to participate in this mass meeting. There is a voluntary registration fee of \$35 to participate in the Republican State Convention and a \$5 voluntary registration fee to participate in the 9th District Convention. Registration for mass meeting participants will begin at 6:30 p.m. and close at the start of the mass meeting. For more information please contact Chuck at 276-639-9199
