OFFICIAL CALL Mass Meeting of Roanoke County of the Republican Party of Virginia As Amended February 23, 2014

As Chairman of the Roanoke County Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, David Suetterlein, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at South County Library, located at 6303 Merriman Road, Roanoke, Virginia starting at 7:00 p.m. local time on March 20, 2014 for the following purposes:

a) Electing a Unit Chairman;

b) Electing members of the Unit Committee as follows: Up to 396 precinct members, respectively, and up to 171 at-large members;

c) Electing up to 975 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention, to be held Saturday, June 7, 2014 at the Roanoke Civic Center located at 710 Williamson Road, Roanoke, Virginia for the purpose of nominating a Republican candidate for the U.S. Senate;

d) Electing up to 745 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Sixth District Convention, to be held Saturday, April 26, 2014 at Lord Botetourt High School located at 1435 Roanoke Road, Daleville, Virginia for the purposes of electing a District Chairman of the Republican Party and electing three Regional Vice Chairmen of the respective districts; and

e) Electing up to 235 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Ninth District Convention, to be held on April 12, 2014 at George Wythe High School located at 1 Maroon Way, Wytheville, Virginia, for the purpose of electing a District Chairman;

f) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Roanoke County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party within the last five years.

A single exception to this shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of this

writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the forgoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception thereafter.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for election for Unit Chairman must prefile a written statement of their intent on a form provided by the Committee to Roanoke County Republican Committee, PO Box 20923, Roanoke, VA 24018 or by physical delivery to 4121 Givens Road, Salem, VA, which must be received not later than 5:00 p.m. on January 24, 2014. Postmarks do not govern. Candidates for Unit Chairman shall include a \$250.00 check to the Roanoke County Republican Committee when they submit their written statement. Candidate filing forms are available at RoanokeRepublicans.com.

Candidates for election as a Delegate or Alternate to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention, or as a Delegate or Alternate to the Sixth District Convention, or as a Delegate or Alternate to the Ninth District Convention must prefile a written statement of their intent on a form provided by the Committee to the Roanoke County Republican Committee, P.O. Box 20923, Roanoke, VA 24018 or by physical delivery to 4121 Givens Road, Salem, VA, which must be received not later than 5:00 p.m. on March 13, 2014 or attend the Mass Meeting. Postmarks do not govern. Candidate filing forms are available at RoanokeRepublicans.com.

Registration Fee and Additional Information

There will be \$5.00 voluntary registration fee to participate in this Mass Meeting. Registration for mass meeting participants will begin at 6:00 p.m. and close at the start of the Mass Meeting. Participants may register in advance by mailing a written statement to P.O. Box 20923, Roanoke, VA 24018 not later than 5:00 p.m. on March 13, 2014. This Call was amended on February 23, 2014 following the release of the Call for the Ninth District Convention which occurred after the publication of the original Call.
