

OFFICIAL CALL  
Mass Meeting & County Convention  
of the Scott County Unit  
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Scott County Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, John H. Kilgore, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held across the county in each of the following districts on Saturday, June 11, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.:

District 1: Weber City Elementary School, 322 Jennings Street, Weber City Va 24290

District 2: Hiltons Elementary, 303 Academy Rd, Hiltons Va 24258

District 3: Nickelsville Elementary, 273 Titan Lane, Nickelsville Va 24271

District 4: Gate City Middle School, 170 Harry Fry Drive, Gate City Va 24251

District 5: Fort Blackmore Elementary, 214 Big Stoney Creek Rd, Fort Blackmore Va 24250

District 6: Clinchport Town Hall, Main Street, Clinchport Va 24244

for the following purposes:

--Selecting delegates to the County Convention to be held on Saturday, August 6, 2011, to nominate a Republican nominee for the offices of Commissioner of Revenue, Commonwealth's Attorney, Sheriff, Treasurer, Supervisor-at-Large, Supervisor-District 1, Supervisor-District 2, Supervisor-District 3, Supervisor-District 4, Supervisor-District 5 and Supervisor-District 6 to be voted on in the General Election on November 8, 2011.

-- And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Furthermore, I, John H. Kilgore, hereby issue a call for a County Convention to be held August 6, 2011 at the Twin Springs High School, 273 Titan Lane, Nickelsville, Virginia 24271 beginning at 10:00 a.m. The purpose of this convention will be for the delegates selected from the aforementioned mass meetings to nominate the Republican candidates for Commissioner of Revenue, Commonwealth's Attorney, Sheriff, Treasurer, Supervisor-at-Large, Supervisor-District 1, Supervisor-District 2, Supervisor-District 3, Supervisor-District 4, Supervisor-District 5 and Supervisor-District 6, and for any such other business as may come before the convention.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

### Composition of Convention

The County Convention shall be composed of delegates of the respective Voting Districts they represent. Representation shall be based on a percentage of 1/25 of the total number of Republican votes cast in each Voting District in the last gubernatorial and presidential election combined. This results in the following number of delegate votes for each District: District One-74, District Two-83, District Three-81, District Four-73, District Five-64 and District Six-57 for a total number of delegate votes of 432.

Each delegate will be allotted the proportional share of their Voting District's vote based on the number of delegates from that precinct, reported to the Convention by district. The delegates shall be elected in the mass meeting included in this call in conformity with the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia.

### Filing Requirements

Candidates for election as a delegate to the Scott County Convention at said mass meeting MAY file in advance (but not required) a Delegate Filing Form, provided by the Scott County Unit Committee. The form may be obtained on the 9<sup>th</sup> District Republican web site at [www.va9gop.org](http://www.va9gop.org) or by contacting John Kilgore at 452-4294, Pat Elliott at 276-275-9733 or Michelle Jenkins at 452-4792. The Delegate Filing Form must be delivered by mail or in person to: John Kilgore, 2050 Manville Road, Gate City, Virginia 24251 no later than Friday, June 10, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. local time, postmarks do not govern. Prefiled candidates for election as a delegate are not required to attend the mass meeting.

Candidates for election at the County Convention as the Republican nominee for Commissioner of Revenue, Commonwealth's Attorney, Sheriff, Treasurer, Supervisor-at-Large, Supervisor-District 1, Supervisor-District 2, Supervisor-District 3, Supervisor-District 4, Supervisor-District 5 and Supervisor-District 6, must file a written statement, expressing their interest in running for election as a Republican candidate for that office, and stating that they intend to support all Republican nominees from the County Convention, and the appropriate filing fee shall be attached for their candidacy forms to be complete. Statement must be delivered by mail or in person to: John Kilgore, 2050 Manville Road, Gate City, Virginia 24251 no later than Wednesday, July 6, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. local time, postmarks do not govern.

If fewer than the maximum number of Delegates that each district is entitled to at the County Convention prefile, all properly prefiled candidates shall be deemed elected.

If any office does not have any pre-filed candidates by the deadline, interested parties may apply with the Convention Nominating Committee on the day of Convention, prior to the convening of the Convention.

### Registration Fees

There will be no registration fee to participate in this mass meeting.

There are mandatory filing fees for candidates for the offices of: Commissioner of Revenue, Commonwealth's Attorney, Sheriff and Treasurer in the amount of \$500.00. There are mandatory filing fees for Supervisor at Large, and all District Supervisors in the amount of \$100.00.

There is a voluntary registration fee for delegates to the County Convention in the amount of \$5.00. Please make all checks payable to the Scott County Republican Committee.
