## IMPORTANT INFORMATION – Appointment of a Proxy Holder

- The appointed proxy holder must be a member of the Republican Party from the same Election District or organization represented by the absent member (See <u>Article VII, Section A, 2</u> of RPV Party Plan).
- All proxies shall be in writing and shall be signed by the maker of the proxy and shall be substantially in the form above (See <u>Article VII, Section A, 3</u> of RPV Party Plan).
- All proxy appointment forms must be delivered in printed paper form at the meeting. No electronic copies or ex post facto proxies are permitted.
- > Photocopies of proxy appointment forms are acceptable.
- All proxies will be examined by a Proxy Committee appointed at the meeting. The Proxy Committee will make a report on its findings to the District Committee.
