OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of Washington County Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Washington County Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Robert T. Copeland, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Holston High School, 21308 Monroe Road, Damascus, VA 24236, starting at 10:00 A.M. local time on March 24, 2012 for the following purposes:

- a) Electing a Unit Chairman, First Vice-Chairman, Second Vice-Chairman, Third Vice Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and General Counsel;
- b) Electing members of the Unit Committee;
- c) Electing up to 106 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention, to be held on June 16, 2012 at the Greater Richmond Convention Center, beginning at 10 a.m. for the purposes of electing a State Party Chairman, RNC National Committeeman, RNC National Committeewoman, 13 At-Large Delegates and 13 At-Large Alternate Delegates to the RNC Convention, and two At-Large Presidential Electors. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Washington County is entitled to 106 Delegate Votes;
- d) Electing up to 106 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Ninth Congressional District Republican Committee Convention, to be held on April 28, 2012 at George Wythe High School, #1 Maroon Way, Wytheville, Virginia 24382, beginning at 10:00 A.M. EDT for the purposes of electing a District Chairman, three Delegates and three Alternate Delegates to the Republican National Convention, a Presidential Elector, and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the convention. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Washington County is entitled to 106 Delegate Votes;
- e) and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Washington County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements

Any person who desires to seek election as Unit Chairman, First Vice-Chairman, Second Vice-Chairman, Third Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer or General Counsel shall file a written statement to that effect by mail or in person, to Robert T. Copeland, P.O. Box 1296, 212 West Valley St., Abingdon, Virginia 24212 which must be received not later than 5:00 P.M. local time on March 22, 2012. Postmarks do not govern.

Registration Fee

There will be no registration fee to participate in this mass meeting.
