

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting
Of the Tazewell County Republican Committee
Of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Tazewell County Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Dallas Sparks, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Nuckols Hall, Tazewell County Fairgrounds, 713 Fairgrounds Road, Rt. 19, Tazewell, VA 24651, starting **promptly at 7:00pm.** on July 11th, 2011, with registration beginning **at 5:00pm, a government form of identification is required for registration,** and ending at 6:45pm, for the following purposes:

1. To nominate Republican candidates for Sheriff, Treasurer, Commissioner of the Revenue, and Commonwealth's Attorney, to be voted on in the general election on November 8, 2011.
2. To nominate Republican candidates for the Board of Supervisors for the following Tazewell County districts: Northern, Eastern, and Northwestern, to be voted on in the general election on November 8, 2011.
3. The transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Tazewell County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Tazewell County in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, a person otherwise qualified shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party after March 1, 2006, or in the last five years, whichever is more recent. A single exception to the foregoing prohibition on participation shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future (the elements of this sentence shall be referred to as the "disaffiliation statement"). Any voter that utilizes the

foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception thereafter.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for nomination for the office of Sheriff, Treasurer, Commissioner of the Revenue, Commonwealth's Attorney, or Board of Supervisor shall file a written statement by mail or in person, and pay a filing fee of \$250 for Constitutional office or \$75 for Board of Supervisors. Completed forms must be received by one of the above individuals, or faxed to **276-988-1877** no later than 6:00pm on June 30th, 2011. Only those candidate forms accompanied by the filing fees filed with the above individuals and meeting the filing deadline will be accepted and certified by the Credentials Committee. **Postmarks do not govern.**

If no more than one candidate files for election to any office to be voted upon at the mass meeting, that candidate will be declared elected. If only one candidate files for all offices to be voted upon at the mass meeting, then no mass meeting will be held.

Mass Meeting Registration Forms and Fees

There will be **NO** registration fee required for participating in this Mass Meeting. Any person who chooses to give a voluntary donation to defer the expense of the meeting should make a \$5.00 check payable to Tazewell County Republican Committee.
