



## **OFFICIAL CALL**

### **Mass Meeting of the Washington County Republican Committee**

As Chairman of the Washington County Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Richard Macbeth, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Washington County GOP Headquarters at 1060 W Main St Abingdon, VA 24210 starting at 7:30pm local time on March 21 2013 for the following purpose:

- A. Electing up to 570 Delegates and an equal number of Alternatives to the Republican Party of Virginia's State Convention, to be held on Friday May 17<sup>th</sup> and Saturday May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at the Richmond Coliseum located at 601 East Leigh Street Richmond, Virginia beginning at 2:00pm local time on Friday May 17<sup>th</sup> [No voting for candidates for the office of Governor, Lt. Governor or Attorney General will be conducted prior to 12:00pm local time on Saturday May 18, 2013] for the purposes of nominating a Republican candidate for Governor, Lt. Governor, and Attorney General. Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Washington County is entitled to 114 Delegate Votes;
- B. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

#### Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Washington County, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

#### Filing Requirements

Candidates for election at said mass meeting shall file a written statement by mail or in person, to Richard Macbeth, Chairman at 1139 Panorama Drive, Abingdon, Virginia 24210 or taken to the Washington County GOP Headquarters at 1060 W Main St Abingdon during normal working hours. This must be received no later than 7:30pm local time on Thursday March 21, 2013 at our Headquarters. Postmark will not govern.

The filing form can be picked up from Richard Macbeth, Chairman at 1139 Panorama Drive, Abingdon, VA 24210, Washington County GOP Headquarters at 1060 W Main St Abingdon during normal working hours and online at [www.rpv.org](http://www.rpv.org) or [www.washcovagop.com](http://www.washcovagop.com). If fewer candidates file for Delegates than spaces available, all properly filed Delegates will be deemed elected and the Mass Meeting will be canceled.

#### Registration Fee

The Republican Party of Virginia is requesting a voluntary \$35 filing fee from all individuals seeking election as a Delegate to the State Convention. Checks need to be made out to the "Republican Party of Virginia". Registration the day of the Mass Meeting begins at 6:45pm and ends at 7:30pm. Those people in line at 7:30pm will be duly registered before meeting begins.
