

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting of the Scott County Committee
Of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Scott County Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, John Kilgore, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Scott County Circuit Courtroom, 202 West Jackson Street, Gate City, Virginia 24251, with registration starting at 6:00 PM and the meeting to begin at 6:30 PM on Thursday, April 4, 2013 for the following purpose:

Electing up to 235 Delegates and an equal number of Alternates to the Republican Party of Virginia State Convention to be held at the Richmond Coliseum — 601 East Leigh Street Richmond, Virginia, or its alternate site, starting at 2:00 PM local time on Friday May 17, 2013 and 10:00 a.m. on May 18, 2013 for the following purposes:

1. Nominating a candidate for Governor;
2. Nominating a candidate for Lieutenant Governor;
3. Nominating a candidate for Attorney General;

Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that the Scott County Republican Party is entitled to 47 Delegate Votes; and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Scott County, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party in the last five years. A single exception to the above shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of the writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future.

In order to be eligible for election as a Delegate or Alternate Delegate to any convention, an individual must be registered to vote no later than the pre-filing deadline established by the Official Committee. A person who has made application for registration and meets all other requirements herein, but whose name does not appear on the local registration books solely because of the books having been closed in connection with a local election, will nevertheless be deemed a legal and qualified voter.

Filing Requirements

There are no pre-filing requirements.

Registration and Fees

The doors will open at 6:00 pm with registration beginning and the meeting to begin at 6:30 pm. Any participant in line at 6:30 pm shall be allowed to register for the mass meeting. There will be no registration fee to participate in this mass meeting. There is a voluntary registration fee of \$35 to participate in the Republican State Convention.
