QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

All legal and qualified voters of Wise County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

FILING REQUIREMENTS

Candidates for the election at said mass meeting shall file a written statement by mail or in person, to Kimberly Mullins at PO Box 970, Norton, Virginia 24273 or 538 Park Ave SW, Norton Virginia, which must be received not later than 5:00PM on March 29, 2013. There will be no registration fee to participate in the mass meeting.
