

OFFICIAL CALL FOR A
MASS MEETING

of the Republican Party of Buchanan County
Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Buchanan County Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Bobby May, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room (in basement) in the Buchanan County Courthouse located at the corner of Main and Walnut Streets, Grundy, VA 24614, starting at 6 p.m. local time on Thursday, April 18th, 2013 for the following purpose:

- A. Electing up to 195 Delegates to the Republican Party of Virginia's State Convention, to be held on Friday May 17th and Saturday May 18th, 2013 at the Richmond Coliseum located at 601 East Leigh Street, Richmond, Virginia beginning at 2:00 P.M. local time on Friday May 17th [No voting for candidates for the office of Governor, Lt. Governor or Attorney General will be conducted prior to 12:00 P.M. local time on Saturday May 18, 2013 for the purposes of nominating a Republican candidate for Governor, Lt. Governor, and Attorney General.] Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Buchanan County is entitled to 39 Delegate Votes; the party plan allows for the election of up to five delegates to be elected to cast each of Buchanan County's 39 allotted votes.
- B. And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Buchanan County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements

There will be NO pre-filing required for candidates seeking election to the position of delegate to the state convention.

Registration Fee

There will be NO registration fee to participate in this mass meeting. Proof of identification may be requested. Registration will begin at 5 p.m. and ends at 6 p.m. The Republican Party of Virginia is requesting a voluntary \$35 filing fee from all individuals seeking election as a Delegate to the State Convention. Checks need to be made out to the "Republican Party of Virginia"
