

OFFICIAL CALL

Mass Meeting of the Radford City Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Radford City Republican Committee, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Nishant Grover, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Radford Courthouse, 619 2nd Street Radford, VA 24141, starting at 7:00 pm on Tuesday May 2, 2017 for the following purposes:

- a) Nominating a Republican candidate for the offices of Radford City Treasurer, Sheriff, Commonwealth's Attorney, and Commissioner of the Revenue, to be voted upon in the November 7, 2017 General Election

- b) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Radford City under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party within the last five years.

A single exception to this shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of this writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception thereafter.

Voters may be required to produce personal identification such as a valid driver's license or voter registration card in order to participate in a mass meeting or convention.

Filing Requirements

Individuals seeking the Republican nomination for the above-mentioned offices must submit a specified pre-filing form in order to seek election at the Mass Meeting. The pre-filing form must be filed no later than 9:00 pm on April 25, 2017 by mail or in person to Nishant Grover, 306 Meadow Ridge, Radford, VA 24141. Postmarks will not govern.

Only those who have pre-filed will be considered for nomination at the Mass Meeting. No other nominations from the floor will be in order. Pre-filed candidates may be required to meet with the Committee prior to the Mass Meeting date. If there is an uncontested race for a nomination, then no vote will be needed. If there are no contested offices, the mass meeting will not be necessary and will then be canceled.

If only one candidate pre-files for any office listed above, that individual will be deemed the nominee of the Radford City Republican Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia.

The Mass Meeting will be cancelled if fewer than two (2) candidates file for every office listed above. In that event, such cancellation will be publicized via email and on the websites and/or social media accounts of the Republican Party of Virginia, the 9th Congressional Republican District Committee and the Radford City Republican Committee on or before April 27, 2017.
