

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting
of the Wythe County Republican Committee
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Wythe County Republican Committee, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Terry Montgomery, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Wythe County General District Court, 245 South 4th Street, Wytheville, VA, 24382 starting at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, May 15, 2017, for the following purposes:

- 1) Nominating a Republican candidate for the Wythe County Board of Supervisors in the District 1-Blacklick, District 3-East Wytheville, and District 5-Lead Mines election districts;
- 2) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the meeting.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Wythe County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, unless otherwise stipulated by the appropriate Official Committee, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party within the last five years.

A single exception to this shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that he/she is in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends, at the time of this writing, to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future. Any voter that utilizes the foregoing exception, and thereafter participates in the nomination process of a party other than the Republican Party, shall not have the benefit of the exception thereafter.

Voters may be required to produce personal identification such as a valid driver's to participate in the aforementioned mass meeting.

Filing Requirements for Mass Meeting

All candidates for election for nomination at said Mass Meeting shall deliver a written statement to:
