$>$ All proxy appointment forms must be delivered in printed paper form at the meeting. No electronic copies or ex post facto proxies are permitted.
$>$ Photocopies of proxy appointment forms are acceptable.
$>$ All proxies will be examined by a Proxy Committee appointed at the meeting. The Proxy Committee will make a report on its findings to the District Committee.
